
CANYON ON THIRD



Electricity for temporary hookups for exhibits and displays are provided on a 30'x30' utility grid system: 120 volts, A.C. single phase, 60 cycles; 208 volts, A.C. three phases, 60 cycles; 208 volts, A.C. single phase, 60 cycles; and 480 volts, A.C. three phases, 60 cycles. Compressed air is provided at 125 to 150 psi and water supply and drainage is provided at 80 psi on a 60'x60' utility grid system. Additional services are available.

At the Phoenix Convention Center, we know there are many tasks to take care of and details to arrange that make planning an event seem overwhelming. Consider this twelve-month sample event planners checklist a starting point for planning your event with us.

12 Months from Event

- Submit an electronic .pdf file of your exhibit floor & exhibit hall lobby plan
- Review the Operations Policy and Procedures and Event Planner Manual documents.
- Conduct site visit of facility and meet with service providers

9 Months from Event

- Review services and general in-house service provider policies (catering, audio/visual, electrical, security, and internet)
- Provide contact information for outside service suppliers, including: Meeting Planning Consultants, Exposition Service Contractor, Production Company and /or Audio/Visual Company & First Aid

6 Months from Event

Submit your credit application for approval

3 Months from Event

- Submit floor plans for Fire Marshall approval prior to selling any booth space
- Submit meeting/ballroom floor plan requests
- Submit preliminary schedule of events and meeting room titles for digital monitors
- Finalize catering, audio/visual, electric, security and internet services with service partners
- Submit preliminary branding/sponorship plans and renderings for approval
- Submit transportation plan and street closure requests
- Finalize outside service contractor arrangements: Meeting Planing Consultants, Exposition Service Contractor, Production Company, and/or Audio/Visual Company, First Aid and Registration Company

1 Month from Event

- Finalize floorplan requests and event specs
- Submit any branding/sponsorship plans and renderings
- Submit certificate of insurance, including an endorsement for auto insurance if loading docks are to be used for your event
 - **Missing this deadline could result in event cancellation**
- Schedule a pre-convention meeting with your PCC Event Manager

15 Days from Event

Submit any last minute changes

We strongly recommend you review these regulations, and distribute them to your exhibitors, to limit any problems or issues. Any reproduction of these regulations may not be altered without prior approval from the Phoenix Convention Center and Phoenix Fire Department.

GBAC STAR™ Accrediation

We're pleased to share that our convention facilities went through the multistep process to become a GBAC STARTM Accredited Facility with the Global Biorisk Advisory Council (GBAC). GBAC is currently the industry's only outbreak prevention, response and recovery accreditation offered by the International Sanitary Supply Association (ISSA) – the world's leading trade association for the cleaning industry.



We achieved this accreditation after demonstrating compliance with the program's twenty elements and ways we will implement them into our daily practices. We will apply these elements to each step in the event process from site visits to post-cons and settlement meetings, including the guest and delegate experience.

GREEN PRACTICES

The Phoenix Convention Center has been a leader in practicing green initiatives. We've highlighted our specific efforts below as we continue to take action towards a more sustainable future.

Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED)

Incorporating a variety of environmentally friendly technology and design elements, the Phoenix Convention Center's West Building has been awarded the LEED Silver Certification by the U.S. Green Building Council. LEED certification is given only to the world's greenest, most energy efficient, and high performing buildings.

Solar Power

On the roof of the West Building is a solar-power-generating plant with 732 thin-film panels that are expected to reduce the convention center's carbon dioxide pollution by 95 metric tons annually, and produce enough energy to power the equivalent of 12-14 homes each year.

Energy and Water Efficiency

Mechanical and electrical equipment are monitored by a building automation system which tracks and optimizes energy consumption levels, reducing heating and cooling costs. The West and North buildings are architecturally designed to create additional shade on and around our campus, while providing natural lighting in the lower halls. The North building also features a water harvesting garden which recycles condensation from the air conditioning units for irrigation purposes. The use of low-flow toilets, water closets and faucet sensors have also reduced water consumption campus wide.

Recycling Program

The Phoenix Convention Center and venues has a longstanding, comprehensive recycling program that includes the collection of paper, plastic, cardboard and glass materials with receptacles throughout the facility. In addition, we use biodegradable and recycled materials in our daily operations and work with clients to maximize recycling opportunities. Last year alone, we recycled more than 500 tons of material.

Green Purchasing

In conjunction with the City of Phoenix Environmentally Preferable Purchasing (EPP) program, the Phoenix Convention Center strives to purchase products or services that have a reduced effect on the environment when compared to competing products or services that serve the same purpose. The Convention Center's green purchases include 31,000 KI Daylight chairs made from recycled car battery casings and seatbelts.

Sustainable Food and Beverage Program

- Local Fresh Through a partnership with local farmers, Aventura Catering buys locally-grown fresh organic produce when possible to provide clients with environmentally friendly vegetarian meal selections.
- Monterey Bay Sustainable Seafood Aventura is a proud participant in the Monterey Bay Aquarium's sustainable seafood initiative, supporting ocean friendly seafood.
- Reusable Cutlery/Biodegradable Materials To reduce waste, Aventura uses reusable cutlery, dishware, linens and decorations, and when disposables are required, products made of recycled and biodegradable materials are used, such as bamboo plates.
- Waste Not Partnership Leftover food is donated to a local food bank or soup kitchen when possible.

PUBLIC ART

Since the very beginning, we have made artwork and the inspiration of native environments a critical component of our ongoing vision. You can experience it within the grandest displays, such as the slot canyon design of the main entrance to the Atrium Lobby or the West Building and the unique color palettes chosen to honor the natural Sonoran Desert.

This approach has influenced every aspect of our campus design, including the indigenous materials used and the emphasis on inviting in light from the powerful Southwestern sun. In addition, we have fostered a dedication to energy efficiency and stewardship of our natural resources, which allows us to properly honor the many artistic influences we've found within the diverse world that the Phoenix Convention Center calls home.


This campus map shows specific locations of public art throughout the PCC.
